Walking the Talk

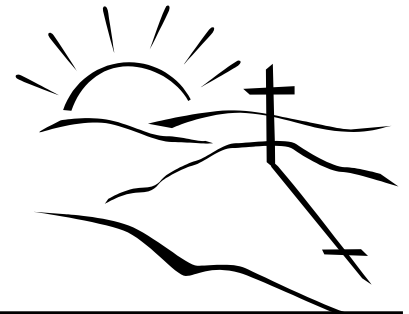
